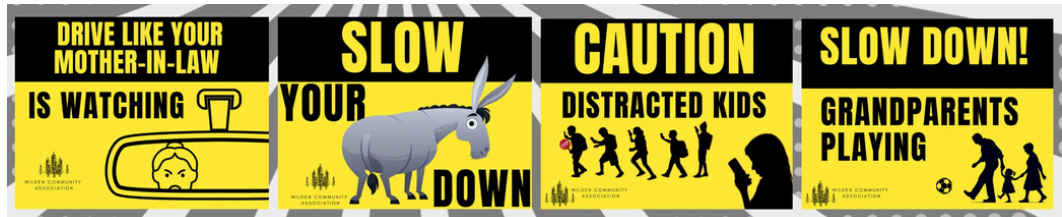
## Events & Updates
