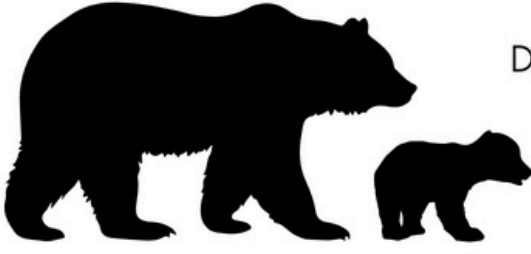

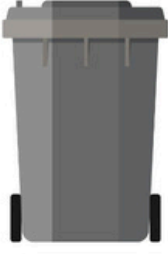
Cattail Pond has been cleared for future townhouse development, and fire mitigation & clean-up work is underway on Wilden Ridge to help protect our community. Union Road is
